Admission and Success Goals for Students from the Bottom Quintile of Income

Since the whole society plays a role in the development of a country, sustainable development is not possible without social participation. In addition to economic growth, supporting the intellectual development of individuals by enriching their cultural background raises the general welfare and level of consciousness of the society. Providing access to education, cultural resources and information to individuals from lower socioeconomic groups contributes to the social progress and enlightenment of the country.

Boğaziçi University implements various strategies to attract students from families in the bottom fifth of the income bracket to the university, to provide these students with access to quality education, and to raise them as individuals who have careers and contribute to society. In this respect, in addition to the scholarship opportunities offered by the Boğaziçi University Scholarship Office, academic counselling, mentoring programmes and career development programmes, which are the basic elements of the university's educational approach, are of great importance.

Merit and Need Scholarships

For students with financial need, different scholarship options are offered according to their academic achievement. While merit scholarships are awarded to students with high academic achievement, need scholarships are provided on the basis of financial need without the requirement of high academic achievement. You can find detailed information about scholarships under the heading 'Boğaziçi University Scholarship Programmes'.

Academic Counselling

The perceptions, habits and attitudes that students acquire about university life from the first moment they step into university shape their subsequent academic years to a great extent. In this process, it is of great importance to inform them correctly, guide them and help them adapt. Boğaziçi University offers academic counselling services to support students in making informed decisions and organising their university life in the most efficient way. Academic counselling is structured as **Preparatory, Undergraduate and Graduate Student Counselling**. Each student is assigned an academic counsellor from his/her department. The counsellor supports the student in various areas throughout his/her university life.



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These supports are as follows:

- **Social Cohesion and Support:** It helps students to adapt to university life and encourages them to take an active role in the university by introducing social opportunities and student clubs.
- **Academic Guidance:** Provides support in planning the student's education process by providing guidance on course selection, academic success tracking and academic goal setting.
- **Career Planning:** Provides advice in line with the student's career goals and directs them to the career centre when necessary.
- **Additional Support and Guidance:** In non-academic matters, the student is referred to the relevant support units at the university (such as health services, mental support, financial counselling).

Boğaziçi University Scholarship Programmes

Boğaziçi University offers various scholarship and support programmes to prevent students from the bottom quintile or from families with economic needs from dropping out of their education due to financial difficulties, to strengthen equality of opportunity and to support successful students in achieving their academic goals. These scholarships are provided at undergraduate, graduate and doctoral levels and are based on academic achievement and need criteria.

Undergraduate Scholarships

Scholarships awarded to undergraduate students are divided into two main categories: merit and need:

- 1. Merit Scholarships:** This type of scholarship is based on the criteria determined by the University Administrative Board (UYK) each year. It continues each semester as long as the student's GPA does not fall below 3.00 out of 4.00 and does not exceed the normal duration of study. The current criteria can be found on the Scholarship Office's website.

Boğaziçi University Scholarship Programmes

1. Need Scholarships: Need scholarships are designed to provide support to students with insufficient economic status and are designed to meet the cash support, dormitory, food and book needs of students. Students applying for these scholarships are evaluated according to the socioeconomic status of their families, academic achievement level and other criteria determined by the scholarship commission. Students who have completed at least one semester in their department are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.00 and not to have exceeded the normal education period.

- **Cash Scholarship:** Cash scholarships provided by Boğaziçi University Foundation (BÜVAK), Boğaziçi University Development Foundation (BUVAKIF) and other institutions and organisations provide financial support to students.
- **Dormitory Scholarship:** This scholarship, which entitles students to stay free of charge in university dormitories, is valid for 9 months (September-May) and continues as long as the student continues to meet the scholarship criteria.
- **Meal Scholarship:** This scholarship aims to support the academic success of low-income students by providing free meals at the university cafeteria and is valid for 9 months (October-June) of each academic year.
- **Book Scholarship:** This scholarship, which is awarded twice a year to cover students' textbooks, is designed to alleviate the cost of education.
- **Summer School Scholarship:** The criteria for this scholarship, which entitles students to take one course free of charge as part of the summer school, are determined by the Scholarship Commission each year.

Boğaziçi University Scholarship Programmes

Master's and PhD Scholarships

Graduate Scholarships:

Graduate students are provided with a limited number of 4-semester cash requirement scholarships and a dormitory scholarship valid for one academic year within the quota. The scholarships can be extended for one more semester upon the recommendation of the academic advisor and the decision of the Scholarship Commission. While the cash scholarships are provided by BÜVAK, BUVAKIF and other institutions, the dormitory scholarship is covered by the budget of the Social Facilities Management Directorate under the Boğaziçi University Health, Culture and Sports Department.

Doctoral Scholarships:

BÜVAK Doctoral Scholarship: This scholarship is awarded to students who have taken at least 2 semesters of courses in the doctoral programme and have a GPA of at least 3.25. The scholarship is provided for a total of 3 years, with a maximum of two extensions, provided that the students are not employed in or outside the university.

- 100/2000 YÖK Doctorate Scholarship: This scholarship, awarded by the Council of Higher Education in order to train doctoral human resources in priority areas, supports students studying in doctoral programmes of universities accepted within the scope of the programme.

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

Part-Time Work Opportunities for Students

At Boğaziçi University, students can work part-time in academic units during the Fall and Spring semesters and part-time throughout the year in various units such as the Events and Organisations Coordinatorship, Media and Communication Coordinatorship, GETEM, Library and International Relations Office. Job advertisements are announced on the university website and bulletin boards in December, February, June and September or as needed. The nature of the job, working period, salary and application conditions are stated in detail in the advertisements.

Part-time working conditions are as follows:

- Working Time and Wage: Students can work for a maximum of 15 hours a week and the wage they receive is determined by the University Board of Directors.
- Contract and Insurance: 'Part-Time Student Employment Contract' is signed with the students who are entitled to work. Students are insured within the scope of work accident and occupational disease insurance.

Part-Time Work Opportunities for Students

- Application Requirements and Exemptions: Students who want to work part-time are required to have no disciplinary penalties, not to have an income at the minimum wage level, to have sufficient knowledge and skills for the relevant job, and to be studying within the normal education period. However, disabled students, victims of natural disasters and children of martyrs and veterans are exempted from these requirements.



Health Services

Boğaziçi University Health and Guidance Branch Directorate provides outpatient diagnosis and treatment services at the primary care level free of charge to students. In this context, doctor, dentist, dietician and nursing services are provided; first intervention is provided in emergencies. ECG, injections, dressings, serum, oxygen and steam applications, as well as vital signs such as fever, pulse and blood pressure are monitored under the doctor's instructions.



Student Guidance and Psychological Counselling Centre (BÜREM): The Student Guidance and Psychological Counselling Centre (BÜREM) aims to support students' social, psychological and academic development throughout their university life. Student participation in the services offered is voluntary and confidentiality is prioritised. In this context, the services offered by BÜREM are as follows:

- Individual Counselling: After a preliminary interview, students are directed to individual counselling services consisting of one-to-one interviews with experts when deemed necessary.
- Group Studies: These studies, which are carried out in a safe environment with an expert, are group counselling services that aim to support students' awareness and personal development.
- Joint Studies: In order to improve the quality of university life and environment, it carries out various joint studies in cooperation with other student service units and academic units.
- Educational Activities: Organises educational events such as seminars, conferences and panels to meet the needs and development of students.
- Self-Help Brochures: It prepares Self-Help Brochures that provide support to students on various topics such as family relationships, friendship, loneliness, self-confidence, stress management, time management and shares them on its website.
- Support for Orientation Programme: In order to help new students to adapt to the university, it provides support for the University Orientation Programme organised by the Public Relations and Dean of Students' Office.



Boğaziçi University International Relations Office

Boğaziçi University International Relations Office provides a comprehensive counselling service for international students. The office provides students with basic information about the university, from the application process to the grading system, from campus life to security rules. In addition, it aims to facilitate the adaptation process of students by providing guidance on issues such as student visa and residence permit procedures, health insurance, transport and living conditions in Istanbul.

In addition, detailed information is also provided on topics such as language, currency, food and beverage culture, climate conditions, mobile phone usage, regulations on drug and alcohol use, and access to health services in Turkey. The information provided by the Office of International Relations guides international students to adapt to their daily lives both at the university and in Istanbul more quickly and smoothly.

Foreign students from low- or lower-middle-income countries or who have economic needs can also apply for scholarships offered by Boğaziçi University Scholarship Office and benefit from them if they are deemed eligible. In addition, students who wish to apply to graduate programmes or current students can apply for the ‘Turkey Scholarships’ programme and the scholarships provided by TÜBİTAK for international students. Turkey Scholarships is a publicly funded higher education scholarship programme of the Republic of Turkey for international students. The primary objective of this scholarship programme is to provide equal opportunities to successful students from all over the world to receive scholarship education at international standards.

General Health Insurance for Foreign Students

According to Article 60 of the Social Security and General Health Insurance Law No. 5510, foreign students studying in Turkey can apply for general health insurance to the Provincial Directorate of Social Security or Social Security Centre in the province where they are located within three months from the date of their first enrolment. The application requires a petition and a student certificate from their school showing the date of first enrolment. Foreign students are insured for general health insurance for one year from the day following the application. Foreign students who are insured must pay the general health insurance premium calculated over the 30-day amount of one third of the lower limit of daily earnings based on the premium determined according to Article 82 of the Law.

Boğaziçi University Social Policy Forum

The Social Policy Forum is an application and research centre established in 2004 at Boğaziçi University to support scientific research on social policies and social inequalities and the training of researchers, as well as to contribute to social policy-making processes. Focusing on human rights, the Forum addresses social policy processes with their historical, economic, political and social dimensions. The Forum analyses social policy developments in Turkey from a comparative perspective in the context of European and global trends. The Forum aims to contribute to bringing the debates on social justice and social policies to the public opinion in Turkey, and to make sure that these debates attract the attention of academics and students as well as the intellectual community, the media, policy decision-makers and implementers.

The Forum's prioritised areas of work are as follows:

1. Social inequalities, poverty and social exclusion;
2. Developments in health, education, social care and other social services;
3. Developments and regulations in the world of work, unemployment, labour relations and the role of trade unions;
4. Pension systems, income support programmes and the functioning of social assistance mechanisms;
5. Housing and shelter policies, public transport policies;
6. Interaction between social actors and political processes in the field of social policy;
7. The impact of global and local political dynamics, international organisations, civil society organisations, humanitarian aid organisations and philanthropic organisations on social policy;
8. Analysing social policies in terms of human rights-based approaches such as gender equality, disability rights, children's rights.

The Forum aims to raise awareness in the field of social policy through seminars, workshops and scientific publications attended by academics, students, representatives of public institutions and civil society organisations. Rethinking Refugee Incorporation

Boğaziçi University Human Development Research and Application Centre organised a webinar titled 'Rethinking Refugee Incorporation' on 5 March 2021. In the event, the inclusion processes of migrants were discussed in the light of current research.

Three presentations were made during the webinar:

1. **Derya Özkul (Oxford University Centre for Refugee Studies)**

- "Recognising Refugees: From UNHCR to state bureaucracies", she explained the transformations in the recognition of refugees by states in Turkey and around the world.

2. **Nihal Kayalı**

- In her presentation 'Syrian refugees and transition to migrant health centres', she discussed the language barriers and system changes faced by approximately 6 million Syrian migrants in accessing health services. Mr Kayalı reminded the aim of the SIHHAT project to bring solutions to these problems.

3. **Sibel Karadağ (Migration Research Association)**

- In his presentation titled 'Afghans at the margins of precarity', he focused on the problems of Afghan migrants living in Istanbul, such as exploitation, undocumented and precarious working conditions.

The webinar provided a platform for a comprehensive discussion on the integration of migrants and the challenges they face.
